# **Generation Zero Carbon Shropshire**

Dear Colleagues,

Young people are telling us that they still do not fully understand what is causing the climate crisis and how their daily lifestyle choices are contributing to it. They are not totally clear what they can do to help improve the situation which leaves them feeling at a loss and overwhelmed about the future. When combined with the recent impact of COVID, things can seem daunting for the younger members of our community.

Generation Zero Carbon Shropshire is a group of young adults aged 16-30 who are dedicated to ensuring that Shropshire's younger citizens have a voice in the ongoing debate about carbon emissions. We have created a pack for schools to use as stand-alone sessions with their KS3 students. The pack includes:

- A video suitable for an assembly, tutorial time, running in recreation areas at break times etc.
- A generic lesson plan for a stand-alone lesson that can be adapted to meet specific needs. Activities can be stretched to allow longer, deeper exploration if required.
- A powerpoint to accompany the lesson plan.
- A key words sheet. Other support/differentiated worksheets will need to be added by the teacher in accordance with the class.
- Worksheets.
- What can I do now poster.

We hope this lesson will suit a range of settings including:

- PHSCE, Citizenship.
- English extend into persuasive letter writing.
- Flexible Learning Days
- Catch up Literacy sessions
- Youth Club, Scouts, Guides, youth group sessions
